GRANDS VINS DE BORDEAUX

Château Vieux Prézat Médoc Aged in oak barrels

The vineyards of Château Vieux Prézat, partly located on the highest plateau in the Médoc, also cover the slopes of the southern hillsides of the commune of Blaignan.

The wine

Location: 11 hectares in the commune of Paillet,
66 km north-west of Bordeaux, near the Gironde estuary.
Soils: clay and limestone, clay and gravel
Grape varieties: 65% Merlot, 35% Cabernet Sauvignon
Ageing: temperature control and 12 months in oak barrels.
Cellaring potential: 3 to 8 years

Tasting

A pleasant Médoc where the predominant Merlot brings roundness and volume.
A good nose combining toasted wood and the aromas of dark fruit (redcurrant, blackcurrant, whortleberry).
A soft, appealing texture, subtly set off by a suitable woodiness.

Serving

Serve with roast beef, a grilled sirloin steak and hard cheeses.
