

## Château De Bordes Bordeaux

The Château de Bordes, situated 17 from Bordeaux in the commune of Saint-Vincent de Paul, has belonged to the Quancard family since 1948.

Its vineyard totals an area of 9,76 Hectares.

### The Wine

Soil: clay and limestone

Grape varieties: typical of: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon

Ageing: traditional.

### Tasting

An attractive, deep and garnet red colour.

A subtle and aristocratic nose with pleasing touches of blueberry, blackberry and Morello cherry.

On the palate, the wine is generous, full-bodied and silky, based on a superb texture with extremely ripe tannins.

### Serving

Sirloin steak or a grilled rib of beef, a fillet steak or chicken in a wine sauce.
