

## Château Carillon Saint-Emilion

Saint-Emilion is one of the most beautiful wine-producing villages in France. The medieval village of Saint-Emilion was accepted by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site both for its historical value and its importance as an exceptional wine-growing terroir. The expression of "the hill with a thousand chateaux" is not just picturesque: This AOC represents more than 800 winegrowers. Their wine is called by English: "King of wines".

### Wine

Location: in the commune of St SUPPLICE DE FALEYRENS  
Area of the vineyard: 11 hectares  
Terroir : Sand and gravel  
Grape Varieties: Merlot 70%, Cabernet Franc 30%  
Vinification : Traditional  
Cellaring potential: to be enjoyed now or kept between 1 and 5 years

### Tasting notes

An attractive ruby red colour.  
A subtle nose with mineral touches backed by the fragrance of dried flowers and almonds.  
A balanced, harmonious, full-bodied wine on the palate with lots of finesse and spicy notes.

### Serve with

Best served with dishes based on white meat (roast of veal or a blanquette of veal) or with wildfowl.  
Tasting Temperature: 16/18°C
