

Domaine Zédé Margaux Aged in oak barrels

Domaine Zédé is the second wine of
Château Labegorce Zédé, Cru Bourgeois.

The wine

Location: 27 hectares in the commune of Soussans,
31 km north-west of Bordeaux.
Soil: gravel
Grape varieties: 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot,
10% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot
Ageing: in oak barrels
Cellaring potential: 4 to 10 years

Tasting

A deep, garnet red colour.
A nose with a subtle and extraordinarily fresh bouquet
carrying touches of dark fruit, dried flowers and leather.
The wine is full-bodied and silky on the palate.
A wine which expresses all the elegance and excellent balance
from its native terroir.
A full, flavoursome finish, reminiscent of ripe grapes.

Serving

Serve as an aperitif, with white meat, game,
soft cow's cheese (Emmental) or a white crusted cheese such
as a Brie de Meaux.
