The wine

Location: in the commune of Saint Vincent de Paul,
17 km north of Bordeaux.

Soils: clay and limestone, clay and flint.

Grape varieties: 50% Sémillon, 50% Sauvignon.

Ageing: at low temperature.

Cellaring potential: to be enjoyed in the year following the harvest.

Tasting

The aromatic palette of this wine, which allies freshness
and sharpness, reveals subtle notes of black currant
and green apples.

In mouth, this dry and nervous wine will delight your
palace by its aromas.

Serving

Entre-Deux-Mers will appreciate accompanied with shells
and shellfishes, as well as of goat's cheese or simply in aperitif.
