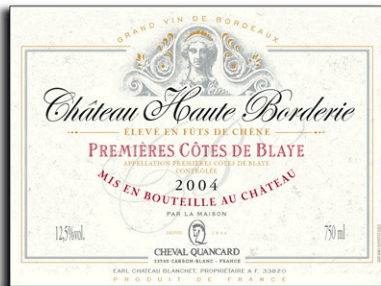


Château Haute Borderie Premières Côtes de Blaye Aged in oak barrels



The wine

Location: 12 hectares in the commune of Saint-Ciers-sur-Gironde, 63 km north of Bordeaux.

Soil: clay and limestone

Grape varieties: 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon

Ageing: traditional vinification, ageing in oak barrels.

Cellaring potential: 3 years

Tasting

A fine, ruby red colour.

An appealing, complex nose of mineral fragrances enhanced by a touch of woodiness.

A smooth, delicate, harmonious wine on the palate.

A full-bodied finish with toasted nuances.

Serving

Best with a beef stew, roast veal or roast lamb.
