## Château Les Joncquets Côtes de Bourg

This family estate is run by the fifth generation of growers whose history dates back to the 18th century.



### The wine

Location: 20 hectares in the commune of Bourg sur Gironde, 50 km north of Bordeaux, on the right bank of the Gironde.  
Soils: clay and gravel, clay and limestone, clay and silt  
Grape varieties: 53% Merlot, 18% Malbec, 17% Cabernet Franc, 12% Cabernet Sauvignon  
Ageing: in stainless steel vats for 18 months, with racking every 5 weeks during the first 6 months and then every 2 months.  
Cellaring potential: 2 to 6 years

### Tasting

A deep, garnet red colour with superb violet flashes.  
A nose of mineral nuances and autumn fragrances.  
Well textured on the palate, typical of the hillside wines.  
Full-bodied and robust with all the promise of a good cellaring potential.

### Serving

Serve with a sauce meat dish such as a beef stew or jugged rabbit.
