in the Bergerac Appellation controlled.

Terroir: clay, clay and limestone

Grapes varieties : Merlot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc,

Ageing: in temperature controlled stainless steel vats

Cellar keeping: 2 at 3 years

A nose with fruity notes, a good balance on the palate.
