



Prestige de Bordes Bordeaux Aged in oak barrels

The Château de Bordes, situated in Saint Vincent de Paul (17 kilometres north of Bordeaux) has belonged to the Quancard family since 1948. In 1975, the winery was equipped with a private vinification cellar designed to take, in addition to the production of the Château, the harvests from small surrounding vineyards. .

The components of the quality drive which resulted in the PRESTIGE DE BORDES red range (aged in oak barrels) and the CHAI DE BORDES (red, white and rosé) consist of picking from a homogenous terroir, traditional vinification and ageing at the Château. This production is today one of the trailblazers of the CHEVAL QUANCARD firm and serves as a benchmark worldwide.



The wine

Location: in the commune of Saint-Vincent-de-Paul, 17 km north of Bordeaux, near the Dordogne.

Soil: clay and clay and limestone

Grape varieties: 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon

Ageing: oak barrels

Cellaring potential: 4 to 6 years

Tasting

A generous, concentrated wine.

A pleasing, garnet red colour, a complex bouquet where the toasted aromas underpin those of ripe fruit and dried flowers.

Full-bodied on the palate with fleshy tannins, elegantly enhanced by a pleasing hint of woodiness.

A subtle blend of the Merlot with the fragrance of toasted oak.

Serving

Appreciate with roasted poultry, white meat and also with hard cheese.
