Vinification Maceration in concrete tanks for a period of 25-27 days at 28-30° C.

Ageing On the one part, maturing barrels and on the other part maturing in tank.

Ageing potential Ready to drink now, this wine will reach its full potential around 2019/2021

Tasting

An appealing garnet red and rub colour. A delicate bouquet with fragrances of bracken, candied fruit and spices. Full-bodied and ripe on the palate with mellowed tannins. A generous and delightfully fruit finish.

Food pairing

Perfect with red meats and also with soft cheese.
