

Here, we go back to the Quancard's family roots.

The Château's vines have to a large extent followed the same destiny as the adjacent Château Terrefort-Quancard. They look down over the Dordogne: a river that offers such promise, fulfilled here with a superb wine, the fruit of a passionate commitment to a property and its terroir. The château's vineyard lies on the 45th parallel, benefiting from a microclimate that is perfect for winegrowing, with moderate heat, plenty of rain and sunshine, and mild winters.

## THE WINE



### Blend

64% Merlot, 36% de Cabernet Sauvignon

### Vinification

Pre-fermentation maceration for one week.

### Ageing

1/3 in barrels.

### Ageing Potential

This wine can be enjoyed from an early age.

### Tasting

Beautiful deep colour with glints of ruby, and a subtle, delicate nose with notes of tart red fruit and raspberries. The palate is fruity and smooth, revealing notes of red fruit and redcurrants, accompanied by supple tannins, A beautiful wine.

### Food Pairing

Excellent with beef, or chicken cooked in a sauce, or grilled. Also goes well with soft cheeses such as camembert, brie or munster.
