



APERTUS LUSSAC SAINT-ÉMILION - 2016

APERTUS is an excellent entry point to Bordeaux's Right Bank, and more particularly the Libourne area, produced in a "satellite" appellation of Saint Emilion: Lussac Saint-Emilion!

Located to the north of Saint Emilion's vineyards, this wine is a tribute to the Right Bank's star grape variety: Merlot.

Apertus offers an introduction to the wonderfully generous, intense wines for which this terroir is known.

THE VINEYARD

LOCATION : LUSSAC

TERROIR : CLAY-LIMESTONE AND CLAY-ALLUVIUM

GRAPE VARIETIES : MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, CABERNET SAUVIGNON Average age of vines: 40 years-old.

THE WINE

Blend Merlot, Cabernet-Franc, Cabernet-Sauvignon

> Elevage In vats and 30% in barrels.

Ageing potential

This wine can be enjoyed now, but will continue to improve for three to five years.

Tasting

This wine has an attractive ruby-red colour, and presents a subtle bouquet with aromas of cocoa and burnt wood.

The elegant, distinguished palate is characterized by an exceptional purity.

Food pairing

Accompany with red meat, game or soft cheeses.
