

Here lie the Quancard family roots. Many of the chateau's vines share the same destiny as Terrefort. They overlook the Dordogne, a river flowing with hopes and expectations, many of which are reflected here in this beautiful wine, born from a passion for the terroir and its history. Straddling the 45th parallel, the vines of the château benefit from a microclimate that is ideal for winegrowing: moderately warm, humid, masses of sunshine and mild winters.

64% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon.

Vinification

Cold pre-fermentation maceration for a week.

Ageing

Ageing of 1/3 of the wine in oak barrels.

Ageing potential

Ready to drink now,
this wine will reach its full potential around 2021-2023.

Tasting

A very fine vintage 2013.
An attractive and well-balanced wine
which reveals lovely toasted notes in mouth.

Food pairing

Perfect with poultry, roast wildfowl, duck preserve or Brie,
Edam or Emmental cheese.
