

Here lie the Quancard family roots. Many of the chateau's vines share the same destiny as Terrefort. They overlook the Dordogne, a river flowing with hopes and expectations, many of which are reflected here in this beautiful wine, born from a passion for the terroir and its history. Straddling the 45th parallel, the vines of the chateau benefit from a microclimate that is ideal for winegrowing: moderately warm, humid, masses of sunshine and mild winters.

TERROIRS : LIMESTONE ENRICHED WITH FERROUS ALLUVIAL DEPOSITS

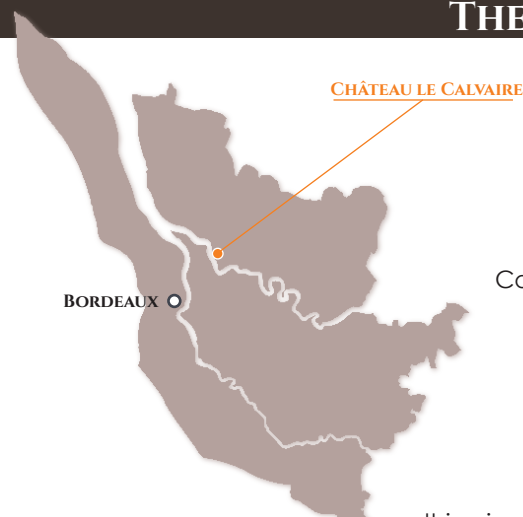

## THE WINE



### Blend

64% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon.

### Vinification

Cold pre-fermentation maceration for a week.

### Ageing

Ageing of 1/3 of the wine in oak barrels.

### Ageing potential

Ready to drink now,  
this wine will reach its full potential around 2023-2025.

### Tasting

Château Le Calvaire presents a vigorous, generous structure with magnificent aromas of undergrowth and candied fruit.

The finish is still quite firm, but should mellow with age:  
a wine worth keeping a few years in the cellar.

### Food pairing

Perfect with poultry, roast wildfowl, duck preserve or Brie,  
Edam or Emmental cheese.
