BORDEAUX CLAIRET - 2018

The wines of the appellation bordeaux-clairet are the wines closest to the wines that were shipped to England during the Middle Ages (French claret) and made the fortune of Bordeaux at that time. They are very refreshing wines of a light red color, between the color of a bordeaux and that of a rosé. Chai de Bordes offers a subtle compromise between the freshness of the rosé and the finesse of a light red.

70% Merlot, 30% Cabernet-Franc

Maturation

Maceration from 24 to 36 hours at low temperature.

A delicate bouquet with the connotations of wild strawberries,

white peaches and raspberries.

A gourmet and unctuous mouth fills the palate scents of the orchard.

Food Pairing

A wine of pleasure that will brighten the beginning of a meal (aperitif, pizza, charcuterie) and will be the good companion of grills on sunny days.
