A deep purple colour. A complex range of aromas from small dark berries to burnt wood on the nose. Opulent, rich and concentrated on the palate, elegantly enhanced by a lovely woodiness. A very fine expression of this hillside vineyard.

Perfect with a leg of lamb, a mutton stew or duck fillets.
