As on all the estates of Vignobles M&C Quancard, the best techniques of traditional and modern vinification are combined with 15 months of barrel ageing to develop all the features of the traditional characteristics of a great Médoc wine.

## THE VINEYARD

LOCATION: CISSAC-MÉDOC. YIELD: 55 HECTOLITERS / HECTARE.

TERROIRS: CLAY-GRAVEL HILLTOPS WITH SUB CALCAREOUS SOIL. GRAPES VARIETIES: MERLOT, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CABERNET FRANC.

Surface area: 12,65 hectares.

Average age of the vine: 25 years.

PLANTING DENSITY: 8 000 VINE / HECTARE.

## THE WINE



#### **Blend**

45% Merlot, 45% de Cabernet Sauvignon 10% Cabernet Franc.

#### Vinification

Cold pré-fermentation for one week at 10°C then a long fermentation for 30 days at 28-30°C.

#### **Ageing**

15 months in oak barrels, one third renewed each year.

### **Ageing potential**

Ready to drink now, this wine will reach its full potential around 2023/2025.

## **Tasting**

Beautiful garnet-ruby colour, complex nose, heavy with scents of candied fruit; beautiful deep ruby with the soft tannins of a great vintage.

#### Food pairing

Perfect with red meat and cheese.
