THE WINE



Blend

45% Merlot, 45% de Cabernet Sauvignon
10% Cabernet Franc.

Vinification

Cold pré-fermentation for one week at 10°C
then a long fermentation for 30 days at 28-30°C.

Ageing

15 months in oak barrels,
one third renewed each year.

Ageing potential

Ready to drink now, this wine will reach
its full potential around 2023/2025.

Tasting

Beautiful garnet-ruby colour, complex nose, heavy with scents of candied fruit;
beautiful deep ruby with the soft tannins of a great vintage.

Food pairing

Perfect with red meat and cheese.
