Presentation

Cabernet Franc is one of the oldest red grape varieties grown in Bordeaux. It is a varietal that gives full expression to the terroir in which it is grown. The resulting wine is usually characterized by notes of red fruit such as bigarreau cherries, black fruit, and various other families of aromas, and always with a pleasant freshness.

Tasting

A warm nose combining notes of green apple and dried grass. A full-bodied, generous wine, offering pleasant retro-olfaction with notes of bigarreau cherries.
