Presentation

Carménère is a French red wine grape that originated in the Bordeaux region. A cultivated European grape, it belongs to the vitis vinifera family. Most plots of Carménère were destroyed by phylloxera in the 19th century. However, a vine was rediscovered in 1991 in Chile. Today, there is renewed interest in this "forgotten" variety in the Bordeaux region. Carménère is the result of a cross between Gros Cabernet and Cabernet Franc. It is often called «Vidure" ("hard vine") because of its very hard wood. Carménère has mediumsized, spherical berries with bluish black skin covered with a non-persistent waxy coating. This grape produces tannic, very aromatic, strongly-coloured red wines with purplish glints.

Tasting

This old Bordeaux grape variety is making a comeback thanks to its unusual spicy aromas and delicate character. An easy-to-drink wine with a very fresh, harmonious palate accompanied by peppery notes. In terms of food pairing, it would go very well with duck breast or game.
