Presentation

Petit Verdot is an old Bordeaux red grape variety.
Having originated in the Médoc, it is now also planted in the Graves region and the Côtes de Bordeaux.
In Bordeaux, it is traditionally used in blends, and so tends to remain overshadowed by Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. However, grown to maturity, it has all the qualities of a great varietal. It produces full-bodied, well-structured wines with good acidity and a broad aromatic range. It is characterized by fruity aromas, such as Morello cherry and blueberry, and spices, particularly pepper.

Tasting

A pleasant, harmonious, moreish wine, revealing scents of pepper, followed by fruity notes of apples and quince.
