LOCATION : CISSAC-MÉDOC.

YIELD: 48 HECTOLITERS / HECTARE.

TERROIRS : CLAY-GRAVEL HILLTOPS WITH SUB CALCAREOUS SOIL.

SURFACE AREA : 4,8 HECTARES.

PLANTING DENSITY: 8 000 VINES / HECTARE.

GRAPES VARIETIES : CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC.

Average age of the vine : 22 years.



THE WINE

Blend

55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc.

Vinification

Maceration for 3 weeks at 20/30°C.

Ageing In vats.

Ageing potential

Ready to drink now, this wine will reach its full potential around 2024/2026.

Tasting

Elegant, harmonious Haut Médoc with a predominance of very ripe Merlot that gives the wine softness and body, accompanied by a few toasted notes on the finish.

Food pairing

Perfect with red and white meat and also with cheese.
