YIELD: 48 HECTOLITERS / HECTARE.

TERROIRS : CLAY-GRAVEL HILLTOPS WITH SUB CALCAREOUS SOIL.

PLANTING DENSITY: 8 000 VINES / HECTARE.

GRAPES VARIETIES : CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC.

Average age of the vine : 22 years.



THE WINE

Blend

55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc.

Vinification

Maceration for 3 weeks at 20/30°C.

Ageing In vats.

Ageing potential

Ready to drink now, this wine will reach its full potential around 2025/2027.

Tasting

Beautiful deep colour with light glints of brick and an open nose with well-integrated oak. The palate reveals notes of paprika and silky tannins offering a harmonious finish. A wine to enjoy now !

Perfect with red and white meat and also with cheese.
