Blend

55% Cabernet Sauvignon,
40% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc.

Vinification

Maceration for 3 weeks at 20/30°C.

Tasting

Beautiful deep colour with light glints of brick and an open nose with well-integrated oak.
The palate reveals notes of paprika and silky tannins offering a harmonious finish.
