Blend

40% Cabernet-Franc, 35% Merlot,
25% Cabernet-Sauvignon.

Vinification

Maceration in thermo-regulated
stainless steel vats for 28 days at 28°C

Ageing

On the one part, maturing barrels and
on the other part maturing in tank.

Ageing potential

Ready to drink now, this wine will reach
its full potential around 2026/2028.

Dégustation

Appealing, bright, purplish colour. Intense bouquet with notes of undergrowth and blueberries. The palate is full-bodied, revealing silky tannins. Long finish with notes of vanilla. A wine with a great deal of charm.

Accompagnement

Enjoy with cold terrines, red and white meat and also with cheese.
